

Equity Market Summary

Today, the Nigerian Exchange Market closed on a positive note following share price appreciation in BUACEMENT(+2.35%) and FIRSTHOLDCO(+2.34%). As a result, the benchmark Nigerian Exchange All-Share Index (NGX-ASI) rose by 0.26% to settle at 152,459.07 points. Year to date returns strengthened to close at 48.12%, while market capitalisation closed at N97.19tn. Activity level in the market declined with the total value and volume of stocks traded falling by 40.28% and 70.00% to close at N13.03bn and 451.52mn units respectively.

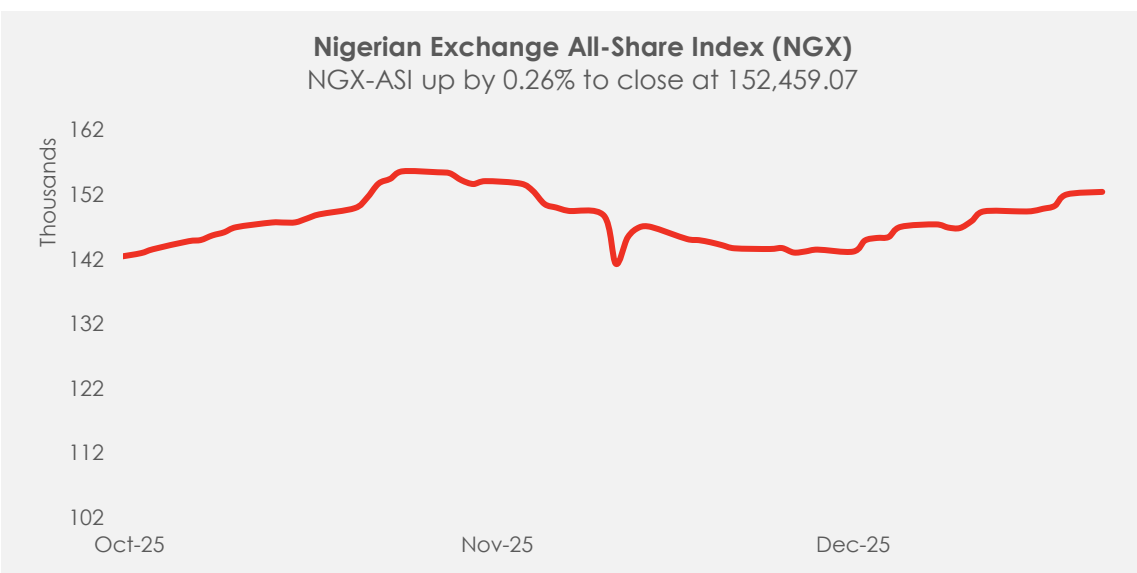

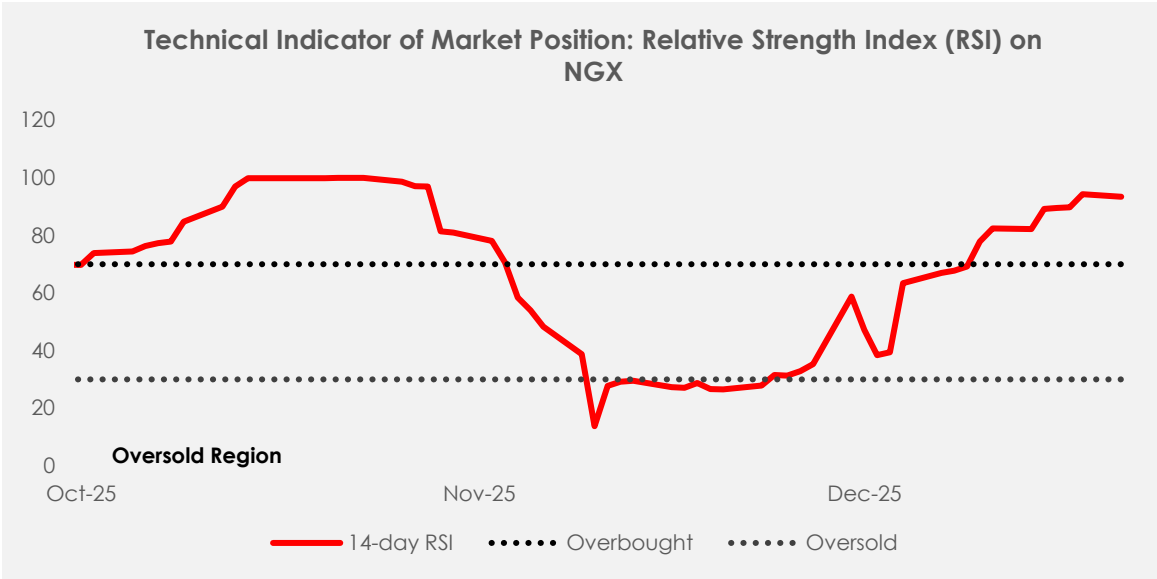
