

BRVM Market Summary

On Wednesday, the BRVM (ICXCOMP) closed on a positive note following share price appreciation in UNLC (+7.40%) and SEMC (+7.28%). As a result, the BRVM Composite Index (ICXCOMP) rose by 0.85% to close at 367.79 points. YTD returns settled at 6.37%, while market capitalisation closed at XOF14.18tn. Activity level in the market was mixed with the total value of stocks traded rising by 5.49% and the total volume of stocks traded falling 69.77% to settle at XOF1.17bn and 0.57mn units, respectively.
